BOARD OF TRUSTEES

- *Met on January 24, February 24, and March 24*
- Held their Annual General Meeting
 - Appointed Candice Heigh as the new Management Trustee from the Holland College Student Union
 - Sent the revised Trust Agreement draft to legal counsel for review
 - Approved audited financial statements for 2020/21
 - Reappointed SBA (administrator/consultant), BDO Canada (auditor), Jarislowsky Fraser (investment manager), and Watson Jacobs McCreary LLP (legal counsel) for another year
- Appointed Tahnia Getson as the new Management Trustee from the Students' Association of Grande Prairie Regional College
- Approved the 2022 APO conference as being held in-person



COMMUNICATIONS COMMITTEE

- Met on February 17 and March 17

Board of Trustees

Five Management Trustees

- Serve a three-year term
- Appointed directly by their student association
- Positions are based on a rotating schedule

Five Student Trustees

- Serve a one-year term
- Elected during the APO



How do I become a Student Trustee?

- Attend the Campus Trust education session, trustee education session, and complete the trustee test at the 2022 APO.
- Announce your intention to run for one of the five Student Trustee positions before June 22, 2022.
- Get to know your fellow student leaders and start campaigning--this is your opportunity to influence the Campus Trust!
- Typically, candidates will prepare a short speech or letter explaining why they think they would make a great Student Trustee.
- Winners are announced before the board meeting begins on the second day.

How do I vote?

- One student leader from each student association gets to vote for all five positions.
- Student Trustees will be announced before the board meeting begins on June 22, 2022.
