## **Board of Trustees**

#### **FIVE MANAGEMENT TRUSTEES**

- Serve a three-year term
- Appointed directly by their student association
- Positions are based on a rotating schedule

#### **FIVE STUDENT TRUSTEES**

- Serve a one-year term
- · Elected during the APO

#### **HOW DO I BECOME A STUDENT TRUSTEE?**

- Attend the Campus Trust education session, trustee education session, and complete the trustee test at the 2023 APO.
- Announce your intention to run for one of the five Student Trustee positions before June 21, 2023.
- Get to know your fellow student leaders and start campaigning--this is your opportunity to influence the Campus Trust!
- Typically, candidates will prepare a short speech or letter explaining why they think they would make a great Student Trustee.
- Winners are announced before the board meeting begins on the second day.

#### **HOW DO I VOTE?**

- One student leader from each student association gets to vote for all five positions.
- Student Trustee candidates will be announced before the board meeting begins on June 21, 2023.
